## Missouri Veteran Directed Care Newsflash: Helping people remain living at home

Ozark Independent Living was recently highlighted in <u>The Licking News</u> for serving Veterans through the Veteran Directed Care (VDC) program. Ozark Independent Living passed the VA VDC Readiness Review in June 2021 and enrolled their first Veteran from the Poplar Bluff Veterans Affairs Medical Center (VAMC) in October 2021. The program has since grown to serve 72 Veterans as of June 2023. Congratulations, Ozark Independent Living and Poplar Bluff VAMC on a successful partnership to support Veterans in remaining in their homes and communities.

### **VDC Budget Reminder and Upcoming Policy and Document Releases**

Reminder about Leap Year VDC budgets:

• The 2023 and 2024 VDC Budget Calculators are designed to account for the extra day in February 2024 due to Leap Year. The "Number of Months in SEOC" in the VDC Budget Calculator will display accordingly if the Veteran's budget crosses February 29, 2024. For example, the "Number of Months in SEOC" will display as 12.03 for a VDC budget effective from 4/19/2023 to 4/18/2024 and likewise wise for a budget effective 1/5/2024 to 1/4/2025.
